

## Missionary Work in the Church Growth Throughout the Years...

- √ 1830 (church organized) > 6 members
- ✓ 1844 (martyrdom) > 26,000 members, 2 stakes
- ✓ 1877 (Brigham Young died) > 115,000 members
- √ 1900 > 253,000 members, 43 stakes
- / 1950 > 1,111,000 members, 180 stakes
- √ 1980 > 4,639,000 members, 1218 stakes
- √ 1993 > 8,696,000 members, 1968 stakes
- √ 1995 > 9,388,000 members, 2,150 stakes (307 missions, 48,631 full-time missionaries)
- $\checkmark$  1997 > 10,070,524 members
- $\checkmark$  2001 > 11,068,861 members, 25,925 wards & stakes (330 missions, 60,000+ full-time missionaries)
- ✓ Brethren project (not predict) according to Neal A. Maxwell, that by the year 2030 (200th B-day of Church) there could be > 90,000,000 members; 727,000 stakes; 4200 missions, 700,000 fulltime missionaries...of course, events could interfere with this growth pattern (i.e. or major warfare, devas tation by natural calamity, disease)
